## SafeCare Kenya Project

We have made lots of progress with our project. In March 2024, we trained our first group of 8 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) in SafeCare Kenya and recruited 4 CHPs for our 'control' group. All are recruiting families to the project. To date, we have recruited 26 families, of which 21 have been eligible and completed their baseline assessment. 8 of these families are receiving SafeCare Kenya and all seem to be engaged and enjoying the program. The CHPs who are delivering SafeCare Kenya are eagerly learning this new program and how to deliver it well with families. They are supported by 4 Trainers who are 'coaching' them on how to best deliver SafeCare Kenya. We are working through challenges (e.g., virtual delivery) as they come up. We will share more details in our next SafeCare Kenya Stakeholder Task Force Meeting next month.
